The AOSR Archives Survey Findings Summary, 8 Aug 2024

The Archives Committee thanks all who responded to the survey. It provided insights and a sense of what options related to archiving, might exist amongst our society members.

A. Survey Duration and Aims:

The Archives Survey was conducted from 15 February to 12 March 2024 The survey aimed to address 2 key questions:

- 1. Did any society member possess AOSR-related documents and physical artefacts (any object) of historical interest?
- 2. Were any society members interested in being caretakers of the AOSR Archive?
- B. Respondents: Out of 24 society members, 11 responded to the survey.



C. Results

Document and Artefact Ownership

- Physical artefacts: Only 3 member societies had authentic AOSR-related artefacts and all 3 planned to preserve them in physical form.
- Digital artefacts: Three societies possessed historically significant AOSRrelated digital artefacts. Two planned indefinite preservation, whilst one remained undecided on how long the preservation period would be.

Hypothetical Scenarios:

 Digitization: Seven societies were willing to digitize physical AOSR-related artefacts upon request, even if they did not originally plan to do so. If they had such artefacts, 6 societies were willing to store them indefinitely whilst 2 only for a fixed period.

Archive Hosting

- Physical Host: Two societies were willing to be the physical archive caretaker one by provision of the physical space and the other for a rental fee.
- Digital archive Host: Three societies responded to digital hosting: one by providing physical space; another by being financially responsible and the third, if a rental fee was paid.

Donations to the AOSR Archive

Five societies were open to donating to the AOSR Archive Project.

Conclusions

- Archive Location: Based on the responses, maintaining the archive within the AOSR (Archives Committee /AOSR Secretariat) is the preferred option.
- Based on the respondents, few societies have AOSR-related physical and/or digital artefacts.

The AOSR is encouraged to know that some societies would consider a donation to the AOSR Archive Project.

E-Archive Progress:

As of 8 August 2024, an e-archive is in the process of being set up by the Committee.

About the AOSR Archives Committee

The AOSR Archives Committee, in its present form, was set up in mid-2021 to develop the archive policies including what to archive for the purpose of documenting the development, achievements, and history of the AOSR; where possible to keep records which has evidential, historic, and emotional values for the purpose of inspiring our members, and where appropriate for promoting the AOSR regionally and globally.
